YOUR HOLIDAY STARTS HERE

The house is kind of well known after the "House warming" incident, but all is fine and we smile about it now !

Mobile phone reception isn't great in the house at present but all the networks are continuously upgrading/improving their signal.

If you are in Fowey and want a cab it is best to book it early as there aren't too many cabs about , there is a town bus whish goes from in front of the church and will bring you back pretty much to the door, but check times , last bus etc.

Most of the pubs in town will do food and it's all good & reasonably priced – although everyone will have their favourites.

THE SAFE HARBOUR.

Bit of a locals pub but they don't bite and you will be made welcome, quiz night once a week pool table and live music (Check dates with the pub) Good Sunday roast and English breakfast.

THE GALLEON

Pool table live music central location and backs onto the river so nice to sit outside. Large menu.

THE LUGGER

Bit old fashioned but friendly good food good price. Try the Rattler if not driving.

THE SHIP

Bit more foody live music Fridays ? Check day

THE KING OF PRUSSIA

Fowey's most prominent pub, on the quay with views over the estuary, good food not too expensive.

THE ROYAL BRITISH LEGION

Sky sports - you can join for a week about £3 – Cheap drinks weekly raffle (As any legion) Friendly staff.

THE OLD QUAY HOUSE

Bit pricey but large terrace on the river with beautiful views worth popping in, when the sun is shining.

RESTAURANTS

THE GLOBE

The best in town can be a bit pricey but dishes to suit all pockets .Well worth a visit, you may have to book.

SAM'S

Casual, bit like an American diner with a cocktail bar upstairs extensive menu + specials big portions very well priced.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Good food good quay side location.

THE BOAT HOUSE

Excellent pizza's good price

There is an **Indian/Chinese** restaurant in town – I haven't tried it but it has been there a long time

POL RUAN

There is a ferry over to **POL RUAN** from town quay .There are 2 pubs in Pol Ruan and you will get a warm reception in either – check return ferry times ! The local beer "Proper job" is a good tipple

POL KERRIS BEACH

There are water sports available on the beach with a cafe/ice cream parlour. Pol Kerris is the nearest beach, 3-4 min drive with car parking halfway down the lane.

THE RASHLEIGH INN is on the beach with good beer good tasty food and lovely place to sun yourself before during or after the beach

Next to the pub is **SAM'S ON THE BEACH** a converted lifeboat station owned by SAM'S in Fowey bit more restaurant but casual. Lobster/Pasta/Steaks/Burgers/Mussels/Pizza – In fact loads ! Reasonably priced may need to book.

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MEVAGISSEY

You can catch a return boat trip from Fowey to Mevagissey in summer. A traditional quirky fishing village with shops selling lots of nick-nacks and nauticalia.

They have a really fresh fish counter on the quay with a great range of seafood caught the same day from little boats that go out as far as the big trawlers !

It's worth a look around and a beer and lunch at "**The Fountain inn**" is recommended (Finish the mixed grill if you can !)

There is information in the house for things to do locally – with post codes for SAT NAV and maps if you want to do walks etc.
